In this first edition, the projects that received awards were first of all, the %Easy Reading Club+ of the Cerebral Palsy Association of Vizcaya (Spain) and, secondly, %Assistance Dogs+ of the Association Handi'Chiens (France) presented by the Association La Vie Sur Bourbourg.

Kepa, a participant of the Easy Reading Club, received the award from Federico Barredo, vice president of the Aluminium, Salt Slag and SPL Recycling Services Business Unit of Befesa. The event was attended by one of the club's working groups, its monitors and representation from the Befesa Corporate Social Responsibility Department. This prize, worth 8,000 Euro, will make it possible to provide reading, audio-visual and multimedia materials offering a broad range of possibilities for participation in the easy reading clubs for people severely affected by cerebral palsy.

With this donation of 4,000 Euro, Befesa will contribute to the education of guide dogs to improve the quality of life of people with functional motor disabilities.
