Befesa celebrates a new edition of its Charity Project Contest

Befesa has organized the second edition of its internal Charity Project Contest, with the aim that employees continue to be an active role in the company's social commitment and can have a positive impact by helping a charitable organization promoting a good cause through a donation.

Among all the applications received in this edition, three of them have been awarded with a donation.

The first prize 12,000 euros has been awarded to the project "emancipaTEA" of the Autismo Sevilla organization. This project develops the employment area for people with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) in the province of Seville, offering training, guidance and advice to families and professionals, promoting individualized training that reduces the limitations of ASDs to be included in the labor market and that sensitizes companies to create opportunities for people with ASD.

Regarding the second prize, the jury unanimously has decided to distribute it among the following projects. Allocating a donation of 3,000 euros to "Sibling trip 2020 to Amsterdam" project of the Kinder- und Jugendhospiz Regenbogenland (Düsseldorf, Germany) with the aim of supporting in the attention that children and young people with limited life expectancy of the hospice and their families will receive during the trip they have organized to make in 2020 to Amsterdam. This trip will give them the opportunity to exchange ideas with like-minded people, forget the stressful daily life and have a good time.

The "Let's go to play petank" project of the Bocce organization (Iskederun, Turkey) will receive a donation equivalent to 3,000 euros. This is a social project for young people between 14 and 18 years who have psychological, social and economic problems, and even physically have lost interest in life. The main objective of this project is to enable these students to reinsert themselves in society by organizing tournaments and championships in which around 100 students participate.

The jury appreciates the participation of all employees who have made their social commitment visible through their collaboration in this contest.
